## iLearn Parental Portal

iLearn is an online virtual environment for teaching and learning which is currently being used in our schools. It is an extension of the physical school, where learning can occur in a safe online environment.

The aim of a virtual learning environment is to involve parents and guardians in their children's education. You will be able to access each child's progress and be

more conscious of what is happening in schools.

## How to log on iLearn

## Go to mygov.mt

In order to log onto iLearn as a parent, you will need the individual eID and password. In order to obtain an eID if it is not available, click on **Register for eID** and learn how to do so. In case of forgotten password, call **21226627/8**.

For those already having an eID, log in by inputting the requested information on the left hand side of the webpage.

Click on **Sign In** to gain access to the portal.

Once you sign in, click on the **iLearn Parental Portal** on the left hand side of the screen.



You will then be transferred to the iLearn Website. Once again, you can log in using your eID number and password. Click on **Log In**.



# The 21st Century Classroom

iLearn is one of the tools available for teachers, which will help in your child's teaching and learning. Teachers can use a multitude of tools where they can prepare many tasks at the same time for their students. For example, teachers may ask students to read some articles online. ## What will your children do on the iLearn VLE?

The iLearn VLE (Virtual Learning Environment) is an online digital platform. Amongst other things, teachers can upload content for learning, such as videos and tools for assessment. This is done so that your children will be able to keep learning beyond the physical building of the school, anytime, anyplace and at any pace. In this way, teachers will be able to reach all students since everyone learns at his or her pace.

# What does learning anytime, anywhere, mean?



This means that teachers will be able to upload teaching and learning materials used in the physical classroom That way, students will have the opportunity to revise what has been done at school from their homes or their grandmother's homes. This also

means that, during exam times, students can also take a look back at all that has been taught during the scholastic year and thus revise for their exams.



## What can we see on iLearn?

- 1. Parents will be able to see the half-yearly and annual examination grades. Gone are the days of waiting for the results to come out. In the future, there is also the possibility that the grades for ongoing school assessments are also available online.
- 2. Parents will be able to learn about activities at school from the schools' virtual room. Heads of Schools and their Senior Management Teams will keep this online space updated for the benefit of parents and guardians.
- 3. If teachers deem necessary, they may also grant you access to the virtual room where your students are learning. This means that as a parent you will be able to gain access to your children's work and help them as needed.



Apart from this, as a parent you have the right to view your child's attendance as well as their grades. At the moment one can only see the half yearly and annual



examination marks. Further down the line, one might also be able to access children's ongoing assessment and marks throughout the scholastic year.

All this is available on Student Data. By clicking on this icon a new room will be opened which houses both the attendance and the grades.

Details for all your children can be accessed by choosing the name of the students from the menu.

In this page, one can also see the students' timetable for the day. On the left hand side, there will also be a place where one can see the results, calendar and attendance of the students.
