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## **TESTING UPDATE**

We are pleased to inform you that testing is going on at a steady pace. Until the 12th of March, we have tested 12,500 children in Church Schools and State Schools. We are so proud of all students taking part in the testing and as a giveaway they are getting a nice reusable mask to help contain virus spread!! For those Church Schools where testing was done before January 2021, a delivery of masks is planned once the schools are open again.



## **CHURCH SCHOOLS UPDATE**

Testing in all Church Schools has been completed by end of January 2021.

All children from Church schools (tested between November 2020 and January 2021) whose tests resulted positive have been contacted for a follow up by Mater Dei Hospital. All the other children attending Church Schools that were not contacted by Mater Dei until today have resulted negative to the test and will not be followed up.



## STATE SCHOOLS UPDATE

Testing in State schools has started in February 2021 and is progressing at a steady pace. Appointments with almost all the primary and middle schools have been set up already. We are looking forward to visiting all the schools and test all the children with a valid consent form / symptoms questionnaire as indicated below:



## **COVID-19 CRISIS - ITAMA'S BIT FOR THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY**

We are happy to announce that the COVID-19 Daily Assessment Application was endorsed by both the Superintendence of Health and the Ministry for Education in Malta.It has been launched and we encourage you to start using it by following this link. Register today for a free account and choose your correct profile. Once your profile is setup including the names of your children/students, you may start using the tool daily without the need to enter children's/students' data again.

#### STEP 2:

We are almost ready to launch our eLearning platform, which will consist of 6 different modules and serves as a guide on the symptoms, the transmission, the prevention and the behaviour in the presence of COVID-19.

- What is COVID-19
- Facts and Myths of COVID-19
- How to Break the Transmission Chains
- What should I do if I get infected with COVID-19?
- The Swab test
- Useful sources of Information

Every module will end with a short quiz to help the users confirm their level of understanding. The platform will also contain a video repository with videos related to COVID-19. Registration for the eLearning will be free of charge and available for everyone.



# **Next Steps**

Schools are currently closed but we are hanging right there. We have everything ready to continue testing when schools are open again.

Once we launch the eLearning platform, we shall proceed with upgrading the Daily Assessment Tool with some new added functions so stay tuned because we ain't done yet!!!
