Final – Judges and Public Voting.

Judging Criteria are as follows:

- Movement to Music;
- Technical Quality (skill level);
- Choreography and
- Presentation (costume).

All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation as well as prizes and awards according to the different stages of the event.
