All submitted work will be adjudicated by a panel of professionals in relation to the following criteria:

- 1. Content and relevance to task;
- 2. Use of language and overall quality work;

- 4. Creativity and presentation.

Three students, from each category, with the best overall submissions will receive a family voucher (1 adult and 1 child) for the Malta 5D experience.
